Webelos Woods is an opportunity for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year Webelos to camp out and participate in activities designed to help prepare Webelos Scouts for the transition to Boy Scouts. The activities are planned by the participating troops for both fun and education. The program is geared to earning activity pins that are required for the Webelos Badge and the Arrow of Light.

Because of the large number of Webelos in the district space is always at a premium. **It is important to register by the due date.** Participants who register late may have to be squeezed into remaining camp spaces.

- ***Every Webelo must be accompanied by a Parent or Guardian. The cost is \$10 per person.***
- Registration by den is encouraged, however individual registrations will be accepted
- **Carpooling is also recommended** as parking is limited. Bring a wagon or cart to carry gear to site.
- **Check-in Saturday 7:30 a.m.** with opening ceremony 9:30 a.m., closing ceremony Sunday 9:00 a.m.
- Dens and individuals must provide their own tents and meals. A bagged lunch recommended. If you don't have tents or camping gear speak to the troop your webelos may be going in to.
- Hospitality is available all day in the dining hall. Coffee, tea, hot chocolate and water for all, however **NO disposables** are allowed in the dining hall. Bring your own mugs/water bottles for refills.
- Benjamin Tallmadge District **mugs** will be available for purchase **\$6 ea**/Buy 5 get 1 free.

- 9:45 am Stations open

- 12:00 pm Lunch (Bagged Lunch recommended)
- 12:30 pm Stations reopen
- 2:00 pm Webelos to Scout Transition meeting. A Den leader or Scout Parent should attend in Training

- 5:00 pm Stations close
- 5-7 pm Prepare, cook, eat dinner and cleanup
